Over a period of 7 days from October 16th Lynda Hillard and three friends will be walking 200km. These four friends, with an average age of 61½, will be walking from Girne to Gazimağusa to Lefkoşa and back to Girne. Their aim is to raise as much money as possible for Tulips (Help Those with Cancer Association) Currently 208,000 Turkish Lira (nearly £30,000) is needed every month to help a growing number of cancer patients here in North Cyprus.
