

Legacy Policy St. Andrew's Church Kyrenia :

At St Andrew's, we welcome all gifts in Wills, however large or small, and we promise to use these gifts to make a difference. Our Church legacy policy is to use gifts to help fund significant development projects, whether buildings, equipment or staff.

Since needs change over the years, we will encourage legacies to be left for the general purposes of the church. We will discuss possible uses of the gifts with the executors of the Will when the time comes, bearing in mind known areas of interest the donor had in the church (e.g. music, buildings, children and youth, overseas mission or aid) and the church's priorities at the time.

The gifts will be used to make a real difference to the future mission and ministry of St. Andrew's Church Kyrenia.

We will acknowledge gifts in whatever way the donor and/or his/her executors feel most appropriate. Equally, we can make sure that gifts remain anonymous if the donor prefers.

We will provide donors with a contact point where they can talk to someone in confidence about the sorts of purposes the gifts might fund, and how (if) they would like their gift to be acknowledged. The initial contact point for St. Andrew's will be the Chaplain who, after the initial discussion, and if needed, will be able to refer interested parties to other members of the Council who can advise on administration issues.

We welcome anyone who wishes to make a gift to St Andrew's church in memoriam, as this can be a wonderful and appropriate way to remember a loved one.
