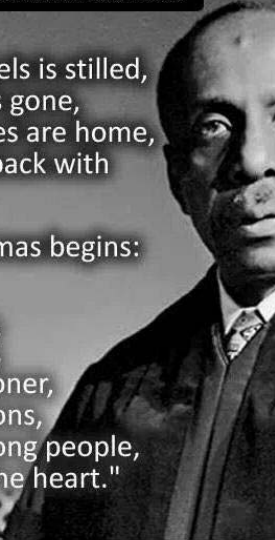


*The Mood of Christmas* by Howard Thurman
